Inclement Weather Guidelines for Outdoor Activities

Inclement Weather Defined

Inclement weather can be defined as any severe weather conditions that include, but are not limited to: Rain, wind, lightning, tornado, thunderstorm watch/warning, and advisories. Especially any weather that compromises the safety of activity participants, staff, volunteers and/or the condition of the facility.

Protocol

Library staff will monitor weather conditions through various sources that include, but are not limited to, weather.com and weather apps.

On-site staff will receive direction from the activity's supervisor if a cancellation/postponement/relocation process is recommended.

Notification Process

Depending on the type of weather event and the impact, the library will communicate via word of mouth and posting on social media regarding cancellation/postponement/relocation information.

Rain

- If rain is forecast to occur the entire day, all outside activities will be canceled for the day (or moved indoors when possible).
- If rain is expected to occur before 12pm, morning activities will be canceled (or moved indoors when possible).
- If rain is expected after 12pm, afternoon/evening activities will be canceled (or moved indoors when possible).

Severe Weather Watches/Advisories

• If a severe weather watch or advisory is issued, all outdoor activities will be canceled (or moved indoors when possible) within the watch timeline.

- This may include winter storm watches, winter weather advisories, wind chill advisories, high wind watches, high wind advisories, severe thunderstorm watches, excessive heat watches, and excessive heat advisories.
- Tornado watches will require all outdoor and indoor activities to be cancelled.

Severe Weather Warnings

- If a severe weather warning is issued, all outdoor and indoor activities are cancelled during the warned timeline.
- This may include blizzard warnings, winter storm warnings, ice storm warnings, wind chill warnings, severe thunderstorm warnings, tornado warnings, and excessive heat warnings.

Heat Watches/Advisories

- If the forecasted heat index temperature for 12pm will be 85 degrees F to 95 degrees F, the decision to cancel or relocate indoors will be at the discretion of the library director.
- If the forecasted heat index temperature for 12pm will be 95 degrees F or higher, outdoor activities will be canceled (or relocated indoors if possible).

Wind Chill Watches/Advisories

 Outside wind chill temperatures of 55 degrees F or lower will call for relocation of outdoor activities (to indoor if possible).

The Eudora Community Library has the right to close the building, cancel/postpone activities, or relocate activities for public and staff safety in the event of inclement weather. Cancellations, postponements, and relocation announcements will be done in a timely manner. Emergency alert warnings may require immediate cancellations.
